Medicaid and SSI Reminder

Beginning July 1, 2019 asset limits for MO Health Net permanent and total disability, aged 65 and over will increase to \$4,000 for individuals and \$8,000 for married couples. The Supplemental Security Income (SSI) asset limits have NOT changed and remain \$2,000 for individuals and \$3,000 for couples.

Remember if you are working to save money for a home, a car etc. and you need to save more than these amounts, you can open a MO ABLE account for only \$50 and the savings will not count against your Medicaid or your SSI. <u>This must be done online through the Missouri State</u> <u>Treasurer's web site.</u>

In brief, if you have MO Health Net but do NOT have SSI, you can have up to \$4,000 in your checking and savings account without loosing Medicaid.

If you have SSI, you cannot have more than \$2,000 in your account.
